This leads to group discussion to gauge comprehension In KS3/4 English, pupils actively read anthologies across the academic year. These anthologies cover a wide variety of genres and time periods. Students are encouraged to read texts out loud during lessons to develop their confidence and articulation. Pupil Premium students are issued with books and study guides funded by school. SEN and LAP pupils receive literacy support via lunch time FLP, personalised Home Learning, Flexible Learning and small group sessions in the WSA. SEN and LAP pupils access a dyslexia friendly library located in the WSA during lunch times.
