Course content

In year 7 students will begin to learn the basic skills of music., through looking at music in a range of styles. Students will explore and develop their skills on keyboard, ukulele, percussion (djembe and drum kit), guitar (electric and bass) and their own voices. As well as learning and improving skills on each instrument, students will take these skills to learn, rehearse and perform music in ensembles and compose their own pieces of music. Appraising music allows students to understand how different styles are created.
